There are several football pitches, swimming pools and a boccie centre, many all-purpose sports halls for handball, basketball, volleyball, martial arts, indoor football, badminton, weightlifting, and other sports.

The halls can also be rented for other purposes such as fairs, concerts or cultural events.

Meet Rijeka as an urban sports area by the sea, in the very heart of Kvarner Bay, with over 25,000 athletes in more than 170 sports clubs.

Let us present our newly constructed sports facilities:


--> KANTRIDA SWIMMING POOLS

Built in July 2008, Kantrida Swimming Pools is a sports complex with four swimming pools:

- Olympic swimming pool 1 (indoor swimming pool with retractable roof) 25 x 53 x 2,2m
- Olympic swimming pool 2 (outdoor swimming pool with baloon) 22 x 50 x 2m
- Swimming pool 25m (10 x 25 x 1,40m)
- Swimming pool for children (5 x 10 x 0,60m)
- Diving pool under construction (20 x 25 x 5m)

The complex also includes two gyms, a wellness centre, a restaurant, cafés, public squares, a public garage, a power plant and various facilities for visitors, making it an excellent choice for sports preparations and recreation alike. The facilities are adapted to meet the needs of the people with a disability.

This sports facility with attractive and distinctive architecture has been designed to host various sporting events and competitions (12th European Short Course Swimming Championships, Water Polo Final Four, 19th Synchro Cup, and etc.).

·--> ZAMET CENTRE

Inaugurated in September 2009, Zamet Centre is a new modern public building with a great impact on the local community. The project is a hybrid, with mixed use of facilities:

- > a multipurpose sports hall
- > a public square and garage
- > and a shopping centre.

The hall has been designed for major international sports competitions, in compliance with state-of-the-art world sports standards and the floor of the hall has been devised according to the FIBA certificate.

The auditorium is a system with telescopic stands, which open and adapt to the kind of competition and the number of spectators; at major competitions 2326 spectators have seating places by opening all the stands.

This sports facility has been designed to host sports events and competitions (15th World Junior Bowling Championship U23, 11th European Individual Chess Championship for Men and Women, etc.). The facilities are adapted to meet the needs of the people with a disability.

--> KANTRIDA ATHLETICS HALL

Opened in May 2010, this athletics complex comprises the athletic hall and the athletic club main office.
The Hall, which boasts the largest indoor tartan surface in Croatia, is a functional facility for a wide range of track and field





and other sports (basketball, tennis, free climbing, handball, etc.). The facility is adapted to meet the needs of the people with a disability.



· --> ASTRONOMICAL CENTRE RIJEKA

Inaugurated at the beginning of April 2009, the new Astronomical Centre Rijeka is a facility that comprises:

- a cutting-edge planetarium with 50 seating places
- → an observatory
- > halls and a multimedia hall.

This bright and modern facility is built to host various lectures, as well as public events aiming at making astronomy more popular to a wider audience. The nearest similar facilities can be found in Milan and Vienna. The Centre is located in the city and it can easily be reached by public transport, thus making it a unique location that is







rarely found in Europe. Astronomical Centre Rijeka is the largest investment in Croatia in technical culture to date.
